




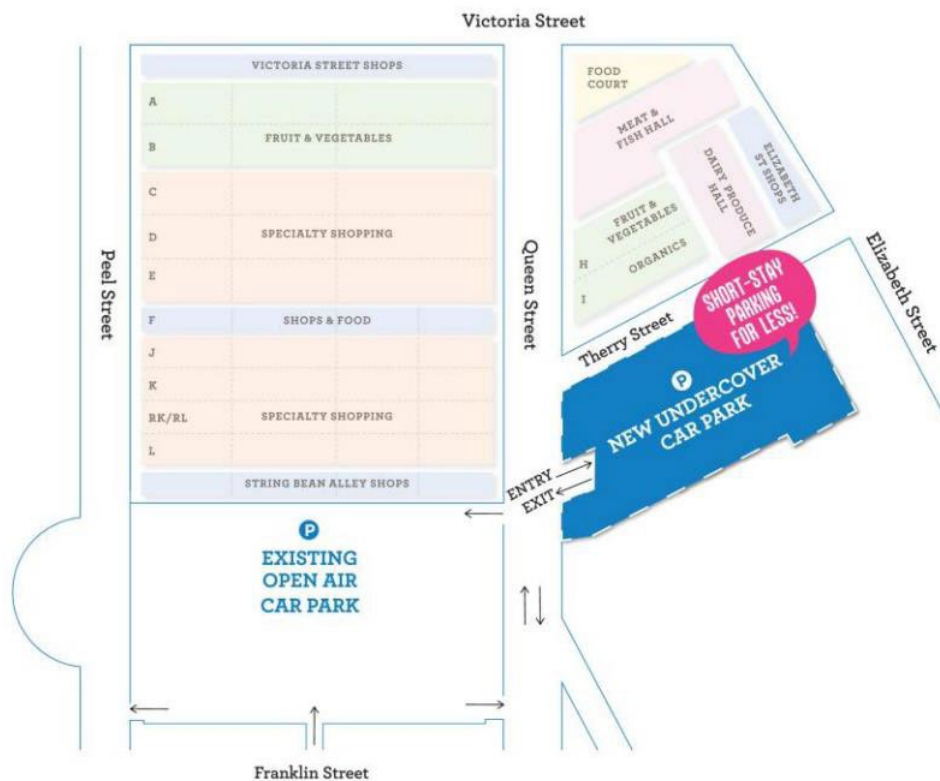


QUEEN VICTORIA MARKET COVIDSAFE PLAN

The safety of our customers and traders is our priority. Queen Victoria Market is a COVID Safe Marketplace and we ask for your cooperation to ensure compliance with the current level of restrictions. These include:

-  Hand sanitising units remain available throughout the Market.
-  A fitted mask covering is not required in outdoor event settings but is strongly recommended in circumstances where social distancing is not possible.
-  Physical distancing is recommended at all times.



COVID SAFE CONTROLS FOR QUEEN VICTORIA MARKET

The [Victorian Government announced](#) that most COVID-19 restrictions will be removed from 11:59pm, Friday 22 April 2022.

The following COVID Safe controls remain in place:

Fresh produce food and drink traders	OPEN with a COVIDSafe plan. All staff must comply with vaccination mandates.
Hospitality traders	OPEN with a COVIDSafe plan. All staff must comply with vaccination mandates.
Other retail (all non-food and drink traders)	OPEN with a COVIDSafe Plan. All staff must comply with vaccination mandates.

Winter Night Market 2022	<p>There are no vaccination requirements for Patrons attending the Winter Night Market event.</p> <p>The existing two-dose and three-dose vaccination mandates for workers on site are still required.</p> <p>Face masks will no longer be required but they are strongly recommended when physical distancing is not possible.</p>
